



Stanway Villa COVID-19 Match Guide

Arrival

- All players, officials, volunteers and spectators to undergo a self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms, and not to attend if symptomatic
- Please travel separately and only with people from your household/bubble
- Please make sure you have washed your hands and you adopt good hand hygiene prior to arrival
- NHS Track and Trace poster with QR code will be displayed outside tea room & changing rooms at Villa Road. Each SV manager will have a personal laminated copy for use at Clairmont and Shrub End (to be left at an agreed place to minimise handling). Home and Visiting spectators and Referee to be advised to scan on arrival using NHS Track and Trace App. Each manager to keep additional manual register of attendees of own team for anyone unable to use the App.
- Please adhere to social distance guidelines and stay 2m apart at all times during and after the match
- Toilets will be open for emergencies, where possible, however no changing rooms will be available.

Match

- Team talks can take place, as long as social distancing is observed
- Warm-ups/cool-downs should always observe social distancing
- Sharing of drinks is not permitted and drinks must be clearly marked and kept separate
- No spitting, shouting, pre/post-match handshakes or group goal celebrations
- Individuals to be responsible for regular hand hygiene practices
- At the end of the match players to leave individually to make their way to their parent's vehicles keeping 2m apart from others
- Should first aid need to be administered, this should be by a member of the same household if present and appropriate
- All Balls to be sprayed with disinfectant before the ball enters the field of play, including new balls that may need to be used during the game
- Balls and training equipment must be sanitized prior to and at the end of each game
- Assistant referee for visiting team to provide own flag
